Three precincts to change beginning with March Election
Whitten precinct located at 140 Scotch St

The Sumner County Election Office has moved three precinct locations within Sumner County beginning with the March 6, 2012 Presidential Preference and County Primary elections.

Those who previously voted at Trinity Baptist Church in Hendersonville will now vote at Merrol Hyde Magnet School, located at 128 Township Dr., Hendersonville. Voters who previously voted at Merrol Hyde Magnet School will now vote at (George) Whitten Elementary, located at 140 Scotch Street, Hendersonville.

Also moving is the Madison Creek precinct location, which previously was previously located at the Mansker Station Visitors Center. Those voters will now vote at the Goodlettsville Nazarene Church, 400 Loretta Drive, Goodlettsville

Voters will be receiving new blue voter cards reflecting these changes; however, those assigned to the Whitten Elementary precinct location should note that the address on their cards is incorrect. The correct address is 140 Scotch Street, Hendersonville.

Due to redistricting, most Sumner County voters will receive a new voter card prior to the August 2, 2012 County General and State and Federal Election. Please remember a state or federally issued photo ID is now required to vote at any location.
