

**Sumner County Election Commission  
Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes  
Tuesday, August 14, 2018**

**Members present:** Chairman M. Allen Ehmling, Secretary Patricia D. Collins and Members, Jeffery B. Hulsey and John W. Smith. Also present: Lori D. Atchley, Administrator of Elections and Annette Haw, Assistant Administrator of Elections. The meeting convened at 2:05 p.m. in Room 106 in the County Administration Building, Gallatin TN and a quorum was present.

I. Call meeting to Order

The meeting was called to order, motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey and the motion passed 4-0.

II. Approve Agenda

The Agenda was approved with a motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Collins, to approve the Agenda and the motion passed 4-0.

III. Old Business

A. Approve minutes of July 10, 2018 with a motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Smith, and the motion passed 4-0. Commissioner Fussell joined the meeting.

IV. New Business

A. Commissioners present inspected 121 newly processed voter registration applications out of the total registrations of 1,206 processed as required by statute with no discretions noted. All Commissioners present signed the report.

B. No appeals.

C. Report from Administrator:

AOE presented the August election results reports and recommended certification of the August 02, 2018 election. Motion to approve by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5-0.

AOE presented Certificates of Successful Candidates for Wall Certificates. All Election Commissioners signed.

AAOE presented November 06, 2018 Poll Worker List. Motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Collins to accept with the Poll Worker List as presented with the caveat that AOE and AAOE may substitute poll workers up until Election Day to appropriately staff the November 06, 2018 Election.

AAOE presented a list of Machine Technicians and Assistants for approval for the November 06, 2018 Election. Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Smith and the motion passed 5-0.

AOE presented a list of candidates for approval for the November 06, 2018 Election. AOE stated that the official qualifying deadline was August 16, 2018 at NOON and the withdrawal deadline was August 23, 2018 at NOON. AOE stated that the Election Commission could tentatively approve the list for approval with caveat that candidates could be added/removed as qualified or non-qualified. Chairman Ehmling stated that he believed it was appropriate to convene a Special Meeting and officially approve the candidates for the November 06, 2018 Election. Motion to approve Chairman Ehmling's recommendation for a Special Call Meeting on August 23,

2018 at 4:00 p.m. was made by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5-0.

AOE stated that the November 06, 2018 Ballot Bags needed to be locked and sealed. Motion by Commissioner Fussell and Seconded by Commissioner Smith to move to the end of Agenda and the motion passed 5-0.

AOE concluded the Administrator report.

V. Report From Election Commissioners

Chairman Ehmling had no report.

Commissioner Smith commented that the Election Commission should consider adding additional early voting days for the November 06, 2018 Election. AOE stated that the County Commission would have to fund. Commissioner Smith also referenced the August 13, 2018 Budget Meeting with General Discussion by all Election Commissioners that resulted in mutual requests for Additional Data to be presented for the September 2018 Budget Meeting.


Motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Smith at 4:10 p.m. to recess the meeting for a short break. The motion passed 5-0.


Meeting reconvened at 4:14 p.m. with a motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey and the motion passed 5-0.


