

**Sumner County Election Commission
Special Call Meeting Minutes
Thursday, August 27, 2020 at 2:00 pm**

Members present: Chairman M. Allen Ehmling, Secretary Patricia D. Collins, Member John W. Smith. Also present: Lori D. Atchley Administrator of Elections and Assistant Administrator of Elections Annette P. Haw. The meeting convened at 2:00 p.m. and a quorum was present.

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order, motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 3-0.

II. APPROVE AGENDA

The Agenda was approved with a motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Collins, and the motion passed 3-0.

III. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. APPROVE AUGUST 14, 2020 SPECIAL CALL MINUTES.

Motion to approve the August 14, 2020 Special Call minutes by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 3-0.

B. APPROVE THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION CANDIDATE LIST.

Motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Smith to approve the November 3, 2020 Election Candidate List and the motion passed 3-0.

C. APPROVE THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION DAY POLL WORKER LIST.

Motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Collins to approve the November 3, 2020 Poll Worker List with the caveat that AOE and AAOE could replace poll workers if those approved dropped out for any reason, and the motion passed 3-0.

D. APPROVE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION EARLY VOTING SITES.

Motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Collins to approve the Early Voting sites as presented. AOE explained the SCEC was awaiting final authorization from Hendersonville Church of Christ for use of the strip center adjacent to the church for Early Voting in Hendersonville. A secondary location was approved at the Hendersonville Library. The motion passed 3-0.

E. INSPECTION – NEWLY PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS.


Commissioners present reviewed 180 new voter registration applications of the 1,791 received and processed with no discrepancies noted and signed the form to submit to the State Election office.

F. INSPECTION – APPEAL PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS.

AOE presented one appeal from a voter who inadvertently checked the felon box. The voter signed and filed the appeal that they were not in fact a felon. After all Commissioners reviewed the appeal form, motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Collins to accept the voter application and the motion passed 3-0.

IV. ADJOURNMENT

Motion by Commissioner Collins to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Commissioner Smith and the motion passed 3-0. The meeting adjourned at 3:40 p.m.
