

**Sumner County Election Commission
Regular Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, November 23, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.**

Members present: Chairman M. Allen Ehmling, Secretary Patricia D. Collins, Members J. Michael Fussell, Jeffery B. Hulsey and John W. Smith. Also present: Assistant Administrator of Elections Annette Haw. The meeting convened at 4:00 p.m. and a quorum was present.

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order, motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Fussell and the motion passed 5-0.

II. APPROVE AGENDA

The Agenda was approved with a motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey, and the motion passed 5-0.

A. APPROVE OCTOBER 30, 2020 REGULAR MINUTES

Motion to approve the October 30, 2020 regular minutes by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey and the motion passed 5-0.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. CERTIFY NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION.

AAOE Haw read the election results. Motion to certify the election by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5-0. All Commissioners present signed the certification documents and the candidate certificates.

B. INSPECTION – NEWLY PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS.

Commissioners present reviewed 48 new voter registration applications of the 473 received and processed with no discrepancies noted and signed the inspection form to submit to the State Election office.

C. INSPECTION – APPEAL PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS.

Two appeals were presented individually by Chairman Ehmling with all appropriate paperwork whereby both voters inadvertently marked and signed their application that they were felons. Each appeal was reviewed by the Commissioners. The first appeal was accepted and the voter registration application was accepted with a motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5-0. The second appeal was accepted and the

voter registration application was accepted with a motion by Commissioner Fussell and seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5-0.

None.


B. ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Collins requested thank you notes be sent to the Hendersonville and Gallatin Police Departments as well the Sheriff's Department specifically due to their support with the early voting sites. Commissioner Collins mentioned she received many calls of no masks being worn that required her to answer that the State Election Office instruction mask mandates cannot be imposed on voting to prevent disenfranchisement of a voter as well as complaints by voters in regards to aggressive candidates at the early voting locations.

The addition of more voting machines and EPolls was discussed by both Commissioner Collins and Commissioner Smith. AAOE Haw stated during a normal presidential election all equipment is sent out and there will always be lines during a presidential election. Chairman Ehmling stated the purchase of additional equipment would be required and the County Commission would have to approve funding.

Motion made by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Fussell and the motion passed 5-0 to adjourn the meeting at 4:38 p.m.
