***CAMPAIGN SIGN POLICY FOR EARLY VOTING
AT THE SUMNER COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING***

In consideration of public safety, property maintenance and the regular conduct of business, the following campaign sign policy applies to all **early voting periods** at the Sumner County Administration Building, 355 N. Belvedere Dr., Gallatin Tenn.

1. Campaign signs placed in the ground on county property are limited to two (2) per candidate. Signs placed in the right-of-way are subject to removal by the city of Gallatin.
2. Signs can be placed in the ground one day before the early voting period begins and must be removed the day after early voting concludes.
3. It is recommended that individual signs not exceed three (3) square feet in size. (Example: 18" x 24")
4. The 100-ft. posted boundary must be observed.
5. Signs interfering with motorists' sight lines will be removed and placed at the north side of the building near the back door.
6. Canopies and/or chairs will be allowed if they do not block traffic or pedestrians.
7. Signs mounted on canopies count towards the two sign limit; no limit on hand-held signs. Hand held signs must not be placed in the ground.
8. Please do not drive any large objects into the ground which could damage the sprinkler system.
9. Parking spots on the south side of the building (Walmart side) are reserved for early voters. Trailers and RVs are strictly prohibited from the County Administration property, period. Car or truck signs are allowed outside the 100-ft. boundary. However, they are not permitted to park overnight. These vehicles will be subject to be towed without further notice. Any vehicle with campaign signage is prohibited to drive through the 100-ft boundary during election times.
