

Candidate petitions for August 6, 2020 available February 3, 2020

Qualifying petitions for the August 6, 2020 Federal and State Primary Election and Sumner County School Board will be available at the Sumner County Election Office, 355 N. Belvedere Dr., Room 106 in Gallatin beginning Monday, February 3, 2020.

Candidate petitions being issued in Sumner County for the Republican and Democratic Primary include Tennessee State Senate District 18 and Tennessee House of Representatives Districts 40, 44 and 45.

While petitions for U.S. Senate and U.S Congressional District 6 are available in Sumner County, it is preferred that they be issued at the State Division of Elections in Nashville. These petitions must be filed with the State Division of Elections.

Persons wishing to run as Independents for any of the Federal and State offices will follow the same petition schedule as those running in the primary.

Petitions are also being issued for the Sumner County General Election for Sumner County School Board Districts 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10.

The filing deadline for candidate qualifying petitions is 12:00 p.m. (Noon), Thursday, April 2, 2020 at the Sumner County Election Commission office.
