Qualifying Petitions for Municipal offices available beginning Friday, May 18, 2018

Qualifying petitions to run for municipal offices on the November 6, 2018 ballot in Sumner County will be available beginning Friday, May 18 at the Sumner County Election Commission Office, 355 N. Belvedere Dr., Room 106 Gallatin, TN 37066.

Eight Sumner County cities will have municipal (city) elections on November 6, 2018 in conjunction with the Federal and State General Election.

Petitions for offices in the following cities will be issued:

- Gallatin – Mayor, City Recorder, Alderman-at-Large and Alderman for Districts 3, 4 and 5;
- Hendersonville – One Alderman from each of the six city wards; Ward 3 – Unexpired Term
- Millersville – Two Commissioners-at-Large;
- Mitchellville – Mayor and three Commissioners-at-Large
- Portland – Mayor and three Commissioners-at-Large;
- Westmoreland – Mayor and two Aldermen-at-Large and
- White House- Mayor and Alderman Ward 1 and 2. (Ward 1 is in Robertson County however petitions must be issued from the Sumner County Election Commission.)

The city of Goodlettsville will also have an election on the November 6 ballot, but qualifying petitions for that city will be issued by the Davidson County Election Commission.

In order to qualify to run for these offices, petitions must be returned to the Sumner County Election Commission by 12:00 PM (NOON) Thursday, August 16, 2018. The Withdrawal deadline is 12:00 PM (NOON) Thursday, August 23, 2018
