

**SUMNER COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES
Tuesday, May 19, 2026 at 4:00 p.m.**

Members present: Chairman M. Allen Ehmling; Secretary Denise D. Shepherd; Commissioners Patricia D. Collins, J. Michael Fussell and Jeffery B. Hulsey. Also present: Lori D. Atchley, Administrator of Elections and Annette Haw, Assistant Administrator of Elections.

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chairman Ehmling. A quorum was present.

II. APPROVE AGENDA

Commissioner Hulsey made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5 – 0.

III. PUBLIC COMMENTS

None.

IV. APPROVE MINUTES

Motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Fussell to approve the April 7, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes and the motion passed 4 – 0 – 1 with Commissioner Hulsey abstaining.

V. NEW BUSINESS

A. APPEAL PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

There were no appeals.

B. INSPECTION – NEWLY PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

Commissioners inspected 85 voter registration applications of 842 new voter registration applications with no discrepancies noted. Commissioners present signed the report to be submitted to the State Division of Elections.

C. REPORT FROM ADMINISTRATOR

- BUDGET UPDATE

The budget approved by the Election Commission was resubmitted by AOE when an offer was made for an amended budget submittal. The Budget Committee had initially cut Convenient Vote Centers, the move to 1019, 355 Belvedere Dr IT Services and modifications to 1019 Union School Road. AOE had received no word as to when the budget would be approved by the County Commission. AOE had advised SCEC Attorney Tom Lee of all budget related matters.

- APPROVE AUGUST 6, 2026 ELECTION POLL WORKER LIST

Motion by Commissioner Fussell, second by Commissioner Hulsey to approve the Republican poll workers with the caveat that AOE and AAOE could replace poll workers as needed and the motion passed 5 – 0. Motion by Commissioner Shepherd, second by Commissioner Collins to approve the Democratic poll workers with the caveat that AOE and AAOE could replace poll workers as needed, and the motion passed 5 – 0.

- DISCUSS EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

AOE stated that with the assistance of Commissioner Fussell, contact had been made with a pastor at LifeChurch on Indian Lake Blvd in Hendersonville. AOE had previously reached out to the church to inquire about a possible Hendersonville Early Voting location without success. Commissioner Fussell arranged a meeting which was attended by him, Pastor Lance Sessions, AOE and Commissioner Collins. The pastor was very open to using the facility as an Early Voting location and provided three available locations within the building. The most appealing was the top landing area inside the old “theatre” which would provide ADA ramp access, separate entry to the voting area, sufficient space for registrars and machine operators within the landing area and a separate exit from the voting area leading down the ramp and out of the building. Motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to pursue LifeChurch as the Hendersonville Early Voting location for the August and November 2026 elections. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Shepherd called for the question and the motion passed 5 – 0.

- **APPROVE AUGUST 6, 2026 ELECTION CANDIDATE LIST**

Motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to approve the August 6, 2026 candidate list and the motion passed 5 – 0.

- **CERTIFY MAY 5, 2026 ELECTION**

AOE read aloud the results of the May 5, 2026 Republican Primary. Motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to certify the May 5, 2026 Republican Primary Election, and the motion passed 5 – 0. AOE read aloud the results of the May 5, 2026 Democratic Primary. Motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Shepherd to certify the May 5, 2026 Democratic Primary Election, and the motion passed 5 – 0. AOE read aloud the results of the May 5, 2026 City of Portland Sales and Use Tax Referendum, combined results for Robertson and Sumner Counties. Motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to certify the May 5, 2026 City of Portland Sales Tax Referendum, and the motion passed 5 – 0.

- **APPROVE 2026 MACHINE TECHNICIANS**

AOE presented three substitute Machine Technicians for consideration. The SCEC had previously approved the same three Machine Technicians for the May 5, 2026 election. AOE requested MS, TD and GCD be approved for the August and November 2026 elections to be utilized in the event the primary Machine Technicians GSH, LM and KW could not fulfill their duties. Motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to approve the three additional Machine Technicians and the motion passed 5 – 0.

None.

VI. REPORT FROM ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

A. CHAIRMAN

No report.

B. ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Collins requested that the SCEC modify the voting time for Hendersonville Early Voting to 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. due to/if location change is confirmed. AOE to pursue commitment for LifeChurch facility use for Early Voting for the August and November 2026 elections, verify voting hours and advise SCEC at either a special call meeting or the June 9, 2026 Regular Meeting, depending on timing of legal notice publication.

VII. ADJOURNMENT

Motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to adjourn the meeting and the motion passed 5 – 0. The meeting was adjourned at 4:53 p.m.
