You are hereby notified that the governing body of the City of Hendersonville has called for a CHARTER AMENDMENT referendum as follows:

“The number of terms served by the mayor or by an alderman shall not exceed three (3) consecutive four-year terms, regardless of the ward designation for an alderman. Current aldermen and the current mayor shall be limited to two (2) additional, consecutive terms.” Voters will select **FOR** or **AGAINST**.

TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND, SUMNER COUNTY, TENNESSEE: You are hereby notified that the governing body of the City of Portland has called for a SALES AND USE TAX REFERENDUM as follows:

“Shall Ordinance No. 22-41 be approved to establish a uniform local option sales tax rate of 2.75% within all parts of the City, except where the sales tax rate is limited or modified by statute, with the additional proceeds from the increase in the sales tax to be used for public safety and street paving.” Voters will select **FOR** or **AGAINST**.
