# SUMNER COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES Tuesday, September 10, 2024, 1:00 p.m.

#### CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Chairman Ehmling with a motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5 - 0. A quorum was present.

An appeal form was mailed to the voter who completed the form that they had not been convicted of a felony. After the Commissioners reviewed the documentation, a motion was made by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins to accept the voter registration application and appropriately register the voter to vote, and the motion passed 5-0.

Commissioners inspected 36 voter registration applications out of 358 new registration applications with no discrepancies noted. Commissioners present signed the report to be submitted to the State Division of Elections.
