



EARLY/SATELLITE/ELECTION DAY VOTING SITE RULES FOR CANDIDATES AND CANDIDATE WORKERS

PUBLIC SAFETY NOTICE

A 10' area at the ingress and egress to the Early/Satellite/Election Day location will be instituted to allow voters a clear line of site to enter and exit the voting locations. No signage, candidates or candidate workers will be allowed in that area.

Candidates and candidate workers are not to stand in the street, driveway, entry way or on sidewalks at voting locations. No sign or person may block traffic or the view of traffic, nor be a distraction to drivers in any way.

Voting Locations may require a specific area in which candidates/workers are to remain throughout the day. The area will clearly be marked with signage.

Candidates are requested to have no more than two vehicles at a voting location for themselves and Candidate workers to reserve parking spaces for voters, some of whom are elderly. Additional Voter Parking may be designated and marked. Candidates may park offsite and shuttle workers to the voting location.

NO Buses, RV's, Trucks/Trailers with Large Candidate Signs, Speakers with Music, Variable Message Signs, Tents (regardless of weather) or Mascots are allowed in the parking area at the voting locations.

* Do **NOT** confront voters to ask how they intend to vote or if they voted for a particular candidate. *

* Do **NOT** greet, call, whistle, harass or otherwise engage the voters. *

Each municipality has sign ordinances regarding candidate signs. Contact each municipality about specific rules for voting sites within their jurisdiction. Standing in public streets or public right of ways is not permitted.

A maximum of TWO candidate signs no larger than 24" X 18" will be permitted at voting locations – this includes vehicle signage. Candidates or Candidate Workers may each hold a sign. Candidates are asked to remove signs at the end of Early/Satellite/Election Day voting. Signs remaining after voting ends will be discarded.

Candidate signs must be placed in specified, controlled areas at Early/Satellite/Election Day voting locations. Signs at religious facilities must be removed Saturday afternoon for Sunday services and Wednesday one hour prior to evening services. Candidates will be responsible for replacing their own signs.

Do not publish/post comments or photographs on social media about/of any voter without their permission.

Restroom facilities at the Voting Locations are **NOT** to be used by Candidates or Candidate Workers under any circumstance, other than once at the time of/if voting personally.
