#### I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

#### FACILITY UPDATE

AOE advised the SCEC continues to operate in two separate locations (1019 Union School Road and 355 N. Belvedere Dr). Attorney Tom Lee presented a formal document to submit to court in regard to space requirements. No resolution at this point.

#### BUDGET UPDATE

The SCEC 2024 – 2025 budget was submitted to the SCC. Meetings are ongoing.

#### OTHER

AOE was notified there is a Special Call Meeting scheduled by the SCC budget committee for June 20, 2024, whereby each department's salaries were going to be reviewed and discussed. SCM recommended all Department Heads attendance. AOE and AAOE plan to attend.

AOE informed SCEC of a Federal lawsuit ruling regarding restoration of rights for felony convictions which has been appealed by the State of Tennessee Division of Elections. Sumner County has 11 felony convictions regarding the matter. AOE has provided public records request as submitted as instructed by the Coordinator of Elections Goins. Media requests outside of standard requests are being referred to the State Division of Elections.

AOE advised of possible Referendums for Portland and Gallatin regarding Sales Tax. Requests for costs have been requested by Portland. Discussions with the City of White House have occurred as well. AOE responded and recommended to each inquiry to hold referendums with the regular November election with no additional costs.
